

The Editorial Board of the AIDA Europe Research Series on Insurance Law and Regulation hereby issues an invitation for the submission of academic papers on **Covid-19 and Insurance**. This part of the series focuses on the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on legal aspects of the insurance contract, regulatory matters as well as specific insurance products.

Eligible topics

We welcome theoretical, empirical and policy-oriented papers. We invite legal academics (including Ph.D. students), legal practitioners and policy-makers to submit their manuscripts.

Papers can approach the issues from a national, transnational, international or comparative perspective. Although the series has a predominantly legal focus, a multidisciplinary approach is welcome.

Eligible areas include, without limitation:

- Regulatory changes in the insurance sector derived from Covid-19;
- Flexibility of insurance with innovative schemes of policies;
- Growing use of technology in every phase of the insurance contract, including contracting and settlement of claims;
- Impact of Covid-19 on business interruption policies, liability, cyberrisk, health insurance, travel insurance, unemployment insurance as well as life insurance;
- Impact of Covid-19 on reinsurance;
- Impact of Covid-19 on insurtech and collaborative (sharing) economy;
- Any other topic related to the impact of Covid-19 on insurance and reinsurance, including case studies on national law best practices.

Submission information

Abstract submission & acceptance procedure

The deadline to submit a two-page abstract is 20/08/2021.

Selection results will be announced by 20/09/2021.

Full papers submission procedure

The deadline for submitting the full paper is 31/01/2022.

The final manuscript is limited to 20,000 words (including footnotes).

All abstracts and full papers should be in English.
