

The Editorial Board of the AIDA Europe Research Series on Insurance Law and Regulation (<https://www.springer.com/series/16331>) invites academic papers on **The Challenge of Sustainability for Insurance**. This book of the Series focuses on the impact of Sustainability on insurance and reinsurance concerning legal, investment, and business aspects of the insurance contract and regulatory matters.

Eligible topics

We welcome theoretical, empirical and policy-oriented papers. We invite academics (including Ph.D. students), legal practitioners and policymakers to submit their manuscripts.

Papers can approach the issues from a national, transnational, international or comparative perspective. Although the Series has a predominantly legal focus, a multidisciplinary approach is welcome.

Eligible areas include, without limitation:

- ESG investments and the insurance business (insurer as an institutional investor and as a company raising capital)
- Climate change and risk transfer products (insurance product perspective)
- How to integrate natural disaster risk management into insurance business models and practices – (losses perspective)
- Insurance for ageing society (pension and long-term care benefits)
- New technologies and “new” insurance business model (open insurance, value chain)
- New technologies, new risks and new products
- Access to adequate and affordable insurance
- The boundaries of the insurance (limitations of insurability due to new risks and regulations)
- Sustainable insurance and Company law
- The UNEP Principles for Sustainable Insurance
- Sustainable Insurance and Supervisory law
- Sustainability risks and transparency (insurance contracts, non-financial information statement, remuneration policies)
- Anticorruption, frauds and insurance
- Any other topic related to the impact of sustainability on insurance and reinsurance, including case studies on national law best practices.

Submission information

Selected papers will be published in a book edited by Marcin Kawiński, Professor at the Warsaw School of Economics, Pierpaolo Marano Professor at the University of Malta, Catholic University of the Sacred Heart (Milan), and University of Latvia, and Juan Bataller Grau, Professor at the University of Valencia. The publisher of this book and of the series is Springer.

Abstract submission & acceptance procedure

The deadline to submit a two-page abstract is 30/03/2022.

Selection results will be announced by 15/04/2022.

Full papers submission procedure

The deadline for submitting the full paper is 31/01/2023.

The final manuscript is limited to 20,000 words (including footnotes).

All abstracts and full papers should be in English.
